The New York State Public Employees Federation, representing 59,000 Professional, Scientific, and Technical workers of New York State, supports this legislation.

This bill would expand the eligibility of disabled veterans for additional credit on civil service examinations. It would propose an amendment to Section 6 of Article 5 of the New York State Constitution.

Under the current constitutional provision, disabled veterans are eligible for additional credit on civil service exams, but the eligibility for this credit is limited to disabilities incurred on active duty during periods of war. This constitutional amendment would broaden the eligibility to disabled veterans without regard to the dates of their military service. We support the goal of this amendment to treat all veterans equally regardless of the dates or locations where they served.

For these reasons, the Public Employees Federation urges you to support this legislation.
