The 7th annual Region 1 picnic was another success with over 300 retirees and active members in attendance. The 1st annual PEF Day at the Zoo, in partnership with Roswell Park, was an overwhelming success. Members are looking forward to next years event.



ast year was very active in Region 3. Both new and existing challenges have continued to confront PEF members locally and statewide. Closures, privatization and downsizing at OPWDD, OMH, DOCCS and OCFS were at the forefront. Our members, along with strong divisional leadership and local PEF staff, rose up to fight the good fight. When these challenges were fast-tracked by the Cuomo administration, some of our efforts fell short. In OPWDD, the Monroe Developmental Center's 3 secure units were closed in December 2013 and at DOCCS, the Butler Correctional facility is slated for closure. Unfortunately, as a result, vital services and NYS citizens within the region are being adversely affected. Fortunately, all of our members were reassigned and remained continuously employed by the state, within the region. Again, local PEF leaders and staff worked hard to make that happen.

The threat of privatization is no longer conceptual. It is real and it is happening now! These are just two examples within the region, but certainly not the only ones. This region and its PEF leaders continue to work in coalition with local legislators, families and community groups as well as with our area labor council to halt or slow down the fast tracking of these efforts.

We continue to support regional leaders and stewards with monthly informational meetings and trainings and also offer additional opportunities at our joint leaderships conferences with Regs 1-4.

In addition, we have an active regional Political Action Committee which meets on a regular basis. This is an especially important year in politics with the upcoming federal and state elections. We are gearing up our PAC and members to support the local legislators who support us and the great work we do for NYS. We continue to work closely with the area labor council and PEF Legislative Office on our political action initiatives. We had a great turnout from our local legislators and PEF members at our annual Legislative Breakfast held in early March. PEF members from DOT, OCFS and OPWDD presented issues specific to their agencies and their impact on services and PEF members. Legislators had the opportunity to address these issues. They also had the opportunity to express support for or against PEF's budget and legislative priorities. It was a very interactive process that worked well.

Today, locally the fight is in the above referenced agencies. Tomorrow, it could be some other state agency. I hope the activities and events in our region have helped to prepare the current and future leaders of PEF, and the members they represent.

PEF and Region 3 will continue to fight the good fight on behalf of the citizens in NYS that rely on these services. At the same time we will advance, protect and promote the essential/quality services our members represent as professional, scientific and technical members of the New York State Public Employees Federation.

I would like to give a special shout out to James Carlisle, former council leader and PEF activist for Division 201 on his retirement. Enjoy!

PEF Division 341 - Chicago

36TH Convention

Division 341 represents about 40 members working in Chicago at the Midwestern Regional District Office of the New York State Department of Taxation and Finance. This division is currently represented by Daniel Zagorscak (Council Leader), Scott Reichert (Treasurer), and Michele Caruso (Secretary).

Our office has two sections, Sales Tax (TTTB) and the Income/Franchise Field Audit Bureau (IFFAB). Although little known in PEF, our members do an important job for all New Yorkers. As auditors, we ensure that New York state collects the proper amount of taxes from companies which conduct business in New York, but are headquartered outside the state.

Last fiscal year our office generated over \$120 million dollars of tax revenue for the state through almost 600 audits conducted outside New York state. Our out-of-state presence promotes tax compliance by all out-of-state taxpayers.

The suburban Chicago location of our office, located next to O'Hare International Airport, provides low cost access to distant audit locations throughout the US in addition to the numerous companies headquartered within driving distance of the office.

Our main issue is still compensation, due to the high cost of living in the Chicago metropolitan area.

This year we had one long-term employee retire, Beth Kulpinski, with over 30 years of service. We wish her the best in her retirement. We also wish the best of luck to our departed intern, Eduardo Espino, and departed auditors, Olga Miech and Victoria Logothetis.
