<u>PAC-</u> M. Blue and M. Chiarello- We will be looking for retiree member support as we approach the budget in 2022 and watching to see what if any attacks on retirees is placed in that budget. We will again be supporting our no diminishment of retiree health benefits as well as the new COLA Enhancement bill being worked on now. We will wait on the IRMMA bill until the budget is released to see if this is an issue of the new governor or not. IRMMA forms will be available on the Civil Service website. You will need to wait for your social security end of year document before you can mail it in for possible reimbursement if you think you qualify. The retirement reimbursement for Medicare Part B was raised from \$148.50 to \$170.10. You should see that change in your January pension statements. There was also discussion on Single Payer that has been receiving some attention in both houses of late. Although tried and changed many times it has not passed in several past years and the feeling is it is too costly for NYS to entertain. We will be watching it. Once the current legislative session has started we will be getting the information on bill numbers and sponsors as well as support letters out to member and will create a link on the PEF website to be able to just send an email to your local legislators on those issues of concern to us and the bills we are supporting.
