<u>President's Remarks</u>- Karen again placed emphasis on RSVP's and a need to strictly adhere to it. There was a discussion on Medicare and the possibility of doctors opting out for a new plan in January 2023. It will be called REACH (Realizing Equity, Access, and Community Health). You should be on the lookout for a letter from your care provider that lets you know their practice is joining the new initiative. Members make sure to ask doctors when making appointments if they are still taking the Traditional Medicare plan before going to those appointments. Those visits will be out of network if the doctor no longer participates in traditional Medicare, and you will be transferred automatically to this new program if you attend the appointment.

TREASURERS REPORT- Current balance is \$19,987.15. This is before the cost of this meeting and the picnic.
