The Nassau/Suffolk Chapter Retirees of the New York State Public Employees Federation, AFL-CIO, has established the CLARA HOFMANN & JEANNE DORRIAN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIPS in memory of our dedicated union activists.

The Clara Hofmann and Jeanne Dorrian Scholarships will be awarded annually and is open to a qualifying retired PEF member, who represent a student who is a family member. The retiree member must be a participating member in Nassau/Suffolk Chapter of the NYSR-PEF for at least a year and must have attended three Chapter meetings. Only one application per family will be allowed. The awardee will be chosen in a lottery drawing conducted by the scholarship committee. Applicants must be enrolled in an accredited college/trade school as a full-time undergraduate student and will need to provide acceptance letter and school schedule. The scholarship winner or designee must be present at the PEF meeting to accept the scholarship check. A CURRENT PEF RETIREES ID CARD WILL BE REQUIRED.

Properly completed applications must be postmarked no later than August 31, 2024. The scholarship winners will be announced at the September 25, 2024, PEF Meeting. We are proud to keep alive a small part of Jeanne Dorrian's and Clara Hofmann's legacy by giving in their names a scholarship to deserving individuals annually.
